Ma. Lourdes D. Maglinao, MD obtained her Doctor of Medicine degree from the University of Santo Tomas, Faculty of Medicine and Surgery, España, Manila, Philippines. She held numerous positions. She has been an Examiner of the Philippine Board of Neurological Surgery She has been elected Secretary, Vice-president and President of the Academy of Filipino Neurosurgeons, being the **only woman** to become President and the **first** President to be re-elected in office. She has been a recipient of a citation for Excellence in Leadership given by the Philippine Board of Neurological Surgery. She was Chair of the World Federation of Neurological Surgeons, Educational Course in Neurological Surgery held in the Philippines and Chair of the Philippine Neurological Association and the Academy of Neurosurgeons, Inc. Joint Congress. She was the former Assistant Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery.

Dr. Maglinao is currently the **Dean** of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery, University of Santo Tomas, Chief of the Section of Neurosurgery, and Head of the Stereotactic Neurosurgery Unit, Benavides Cancer Institute, UST Hospital.
